God sees us all. The Mexican weaving cross shows the Eye of God.

- Tie 2 sticks or lolly sticks together to make a cross.
- Take a length of yarn and wrap one end twice around the middle of the cross. Turn the cross in your hand and wrap the yarn twice around the middle to form an X
- Always weaving in the same direction, wrap the yarn once around the next stick, and then crossways to the next stick.
- You should see a box shape appearing.
- You can change the colour of your yarn as you wish.
 Just continue from the previous colour and tuck the
 loose ends behind the cross and weave them in as you
 turn the cross.
